
How to make a Pom-Pom Stuff Busy Bag

Materials:

- 1 small plastic container with lid (empty and cleaned yogurt or sour cream container works well)
- various sizes of pom-poms
- printer
- scissors
- clear packaging tape

Instructions:

1. Use your scissors to cut two or three small circular holes in the lid of the container. You can make them all the same size or make them different sizes to make this activity more challenging. Place the lid back on the container and put it into zip-top bag.
2. Add the pom-poms to the bag.
3. Print the Busy Bag label on regular weight printer paper. Cut it out on the solid lines. Use clear packaging tape to cover and secure the label to the front of the zip-top bag.



Pom-Pom Stuff

Push the pom-poms into the holes on the top of the container.
Do all the pom-pom fit through all the holes?

Activity Develops or Reinforces: visual discrimination, fine motor skills

This bag includes: container with lid, po-poms
